RULES/TOURNAMENT HOTLINE

If, during your round, you are in need of a ruling or rules official assistance, please call the tournament hotline at **949-828-GOLF**. Cell phones may ONLY be used by a player or caddie to **1) access tournament information, 2) obtain yardages via GPS, 3) contact the rules hotline, or 4) in emergency situations.** Cell phones may not be used for any other purposes.

Important Course Information

- **Make sure you bring the drivers license that is on file!!!**
- Parents cannot come and go and try to get back on the base later
- If there is an issue with your access to the base (for those of you who have filled out the form), we will reach out to you separately. If you do not receive anything from us separately, you will be good to go for the tournament!!

- **IMPORTANT: We will ONLY have access to the San Luis Rey Gate.** We will be turned away from any other gate on base. Here are the directions to go to Marine Memorial GC:

Pace of Play Policy

- Your player will get a **2 stroke penalty** added to their last hole of the tournament if they finish more than 19 min behind the group in front. **This will be timed by when you arrive at the scoring table, NOT when you complete the hole.** Please keep checking on your players time par after each hole and walk quickly over to the scoring table once you finish your round.

Cart Policy

- All players must walk during the play of each hole. Only Caddies for 9-hole players and spectators may rent a cart for use during play to help shuttle 9-hole players between holes. Spectator carts please be respectful and aware of the group behind. After reaching the tee, players must walk until the completion of the hole. The caddie may leave the bag on the cart or carry it on the course when needed. Caddies for 18-hole

players may not use carts unless approved by the tournament director before the start of the round.

Caddie Tips

- Can not deliberately stand behind player when they are attempting to address the ball, 2 stroke penalty
- Caddies should not approach and talk to other players they are not caddying for. Only talk to other caddies if you have a question about the other player.
- Caddies are responsible for making sure the players are in position and knowing when they are out of position regarding pace of play

Dress Code

- Players, caddies, and spectators are expected to dress accordingly to respect the course and the game of golf. No t-shirts, jeans, etc.

Tips for a Better Round

- **Play Ready Golf**
 - ON THE TEE:** whoever is ready tees off, not the honors system
 - ON THE FAIRWAY:** 40 seconds MAX to hit each shot
 - ON THE GREEN:** continuous putting when able
- The last two people in a group to finish should stay on the green, everyone else can head up to the next tee box.
- Prepare for your shot **while** other players are preparing for their shot when possible without being distracting
- Park your golf bag **between** the green and the next teeing ground (never in front of the green!!)

- Ties: First place ties are a sudden death play-off. Card offs if not able to play due to weather or darkness.
